All abstracts should be submitted via e-mail to k.fiddes@alfred.org.au
by 5pm AUST EST 26th April, 2010.

All abstracts should include the complete contact information for the presenting author. All accepted abstracts will be published in the Conference Proceedings and will be available to all registrants at the 2010 annual meeting.

Abstracts should have a maximum of 450 words and include the title, authors, a concise summary of the, contact details of the presenter, organisation, and indicate preference for consideration as oral presentation or poster.

Abstract Format Guidelines

Title

The abstract title should be in upper case, Arial, Bold, 12pt size and left justified

Authors

The title should be followed by presenting authors' first and last name in bold followed by co-authors (first initial and last name). Superscript numbers after each author's name should be used to indicate the authors' affiliation (department followed by institution/organisation, city, state and country). See example below:

Peter Jones¹, L.Smith², D. M^CCormack^{1,2}

² Department of Medicine, University of Melbourne, Melbourne, Victoria, Australia

Abstract

The abstract should

- **be submitted in 10 point Arial font**
- **include the following headings: *Introduction/Background, Methods, Results and Conclusions***
- **have a maximum of 450 words, including references where applicable.**

Format

The required format is MS Word.

Figures and Tables

Figures and tables can be included in the abstracts.

References

In the text the citations should be in the format of author(s) and year e.g. (Bazata, 2008). References should be listed in alphabetical order at the end of the abstract and should include authors' last names and initials, year of publication, the name of the journal, volume number and page numbers.
